This event celebrates the talents of our state's young artists and is sponsored by Historic Cane Hill, Inc., and the University of Arkansas School of Art at Fayetteville.

Competition Eligibility

The competition is open to all residents of Arkansas who are students in grades 10 through 12, including public, private, and home-schooled. Competition entries may be in any medium, including drawing, painting, etching, lithography, block-cut printing, digital art, photography, sculpture, ceramics, textile, collage, and mixed-media. All genres, styles, and subject matter are welcomed. In order to be eligible for the Grand Prize Historic Cane Hill Young Artist Scholarship, seniors must submit 3 works and an artist's statement.

Awards

The competition's **Grand Prize** is the **Historic Cane Hill Young Artist Scholarship**, a one-year scholarship to the University of Arkansas School of Art in Fayetteville. The prize includes the cost of tuition and fees for full-time enrollment in the 2026-2027 academic year.* This is a partnership between the University of Arkansas School of Art through the Fulbright College of Arts & Sciences and Historic Cane Hill to provide Arkansas' young artists with the opportunity to pursue their work through higher education in the state. Additional **cash awards** will be distributed to other winning artists.

Award winners will be announced at the Awards Ceremony and Opening Reception to be held on Saturday, November 15, 2025 at Historic Cane Hill.

Host:

This competition is hosted by Historic Cane Hill, Inc., a 501(c)3 non-profit organization based in the picturesque, art-friendly community of Cane Hill in Northwest Arkansas. Historic Cane Hill, Inc. is responsible for ambitious efforts to preserve and restore this historic community and is committed to the support and advancement of the arts as a primary component of revitalization efforts. Cane Hill College, chartered in 1852, was one of the first 4-year collegiate institutions in Arkansas and boasted an active program of painting and drawing in the 19th century. This competition honors that legacy.

Exhibition Details

The exhibition will be held in the Gallery at Historic Cane Hill. The gallery is housed in the historic A.R. Carroll building in Cane Hill, Arkansas. The building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is located amid a dense concentration of beautiful historic architecture. The recently restored building was constructed in 1900 and contains 1,000 square feet of gallery space. The gallery is adjacent to the Historic Cane Hill Museum. Cane Hill is situated in Northwest Arkansas' burgeoning art corridor, just 20 miles west of Fayetteville, and 45 miles from Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art, in Bentonville.

How to Enter:

Digital images of artwork, along with registration information, are to be submitted through the SlideRoom app. Each artist may enter a maximum of 3 works of art. There is no entry fee. To enter, open UA's SlideRoom Page at <https://uarkart.slideroom.com> and click

In order to be eligible for the grand prize Historic Cane Hill Young Artist Scholarship, seniors must submit 3 works and an artist's statement.

Publication

A digital exhibition catalog will be produced, containing the names of all exhibiting artists and award winners. The digital publication will be made available at historiccanehill.org after the awards are announced.

Artwork Presentation and Restrictions

All 2-dimensional works must be framed, and/or matted. All mats must be white or off-white in color. 2-dimensional work should not exceed 30 inches in any single dimension (not including mat and/or frame). Sculptural work must not exceed a total weight of 50 lbs. and not extend greater than 36" in any direction. **All artwork must be original.**

Juror(s)

The names of the competition juror(s) will be announced prior to the close of the entry deadline. Jury will be composed of representatives from Historic Cane Hill, the University of Arkansas School of Art, and/or the Arkansas art community at large.

Sales

Artists may choose to make their artwork available for public purchase during the exhibition. If the artwork is available for purchase, the artist must indicate the sale price. If artwork is not available for purchase, it will be marked as NFS. Historic Cane Hill, Inc. will charge a sales commission of 15% of the sales price for any work sold during the exhibition. All sales will be conducted by representatives of Historic Cane Hill, Inc. and all monies will be collected by Historic Cane Hill, Inc. Applicable sales tax will be calculated, based on the indicated sales price of artwork sold. Sales tax will be included in the total sales price due from the buyer. Historic Cane Hill, Inc. will remit collected sales tax to the appropriate agencies. Payment for artwork sold during the exhibition will be forwarded to the artist in the amount of the indicated sale price, minus sales commission. Payment to the artist will be made no later than 30 days after the close of the exhibition. Payments will be delivered to the artist's address indicated on the exhibition entry form, via USPS. All proceeds generated from artwork sales and entry fees will benefit Historic Cane Hill, Inc.

Artwork Delivery

Artwork which has been accepted into the exhibition may be shipped to the exhibition location or delivered in person between Friday, October 17, and Friday, October 31. Please arrange for shipments to arrive during the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM. All shipments **must** arrive no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, October 31. Arrangements for after-hours delivery should be made in advance. Artists are responsible for providing insurance for artwork during shipping. All artwork delivered to the exhibition location must include an identification tag attached to the back of the artwork, containing the artist's name, address, phone number, email address, title of the work, and sale price (if applicable). A number of artwork pick-up locations around the state are being developed. Please inquire for locations.

Artwork return

All unsold artwork that was dropped-off in person must be picked-up in person at the exhibition location between Monday, January 19 and Saturday, February 7, 2026. Historic Cane Hill is open Monday - Friday from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM and on Saturdays from 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM. All unsold artwork which was shipped to the exhibition location will be returned to the artist in their original shipping container. **All artwork shipped to the location MUST have pre-paid return postage enclosed,** unless it is to be picked-up in person following the exhibition. Artwork sold during the exhibition will be released to the buyer immediately upon completion of the exhibition. Buyers may pick-up the artwork in person. Buyers wishing to have artwork shipped, are responsible for making all arrangements with the artist for pick-up, packing, and shipping, and are responsible for all related costs. **If you do not pick up your art work by Feb. 7, it will not be stored.**

* Dispersal of the Grand Prize award will be contingent upon successful admission to the University of Arkansas and enrollment as a major within the School of Art starting in Fall 2026. The award is not redeemable as cash and will be applied only to tuition and fees through the University of Arkansas scholarship office. Value of the award is approximately \$10,000 for 30 hours of credit (15 per semester) plus applicable fees for a total value not to exceed \$10,000.
